

Win a 7-night stay in Monteverdi, Tuscany at the Villa Muri Antichi

Guidelines for Seeking Donations

Drawing held: November 18, 2017 at the American Cancer Society's Striders' Ball

The prize: A seven-night stay at the Villa Muri Antichi, the premier Montverdi villa in Monteverdi, Tuscany. This stay is valued at \$23,500! Plus, the prize sponsor has also very generously agreed to pay the estimated taxes on the prize value upon award!

The total package has a fair market value of \$29,375!

Please note what is included in the prize and communicate the exclusions to the prize offered:

The prize includes:

- Seven Nights at the Villa Muri Antichi, the premier Montverdi villa for up to 12 family members and friends. The villa has six bedrooms and six and a half baths.
- Estimated federal winner's tax of \$5,875 (25% of the fair market value of the stay at the villa) will be payable via check to the winner within 10 business days of prize award. These funds can be used to offset income tax related to prize winnings.

This prize does not include any other travel expenses including airfare, ground transportation, fees, taxes, gratuity, meals, excursions, or any other travel expenses incurred.

This stay must be redeemed by November 1, 2018. Black-out dates may apply.

Please communicate winner's tax implications:

Prize winner must complete and sign an IRS Form W-9 before being awarded the prize. Winner will receive a 1099-Misc for tax purposes in February, 2018, which reflects the total prize award including the trip (\$23,500) and estimated taxes (\$5,875). The winner is responsible for paying all associated state and Federal taxes.

Please note the following information to ensure a successful drawing:

- The suggested donation for each ticket is \$250.
- The suggested donation for five tickets is \$1000.
- There is no purchase required to participate. Anyone who would like a free ticket may have one upon request. Limit of one free ticket per eligible participant. Free ticket is available by contacting Matthew Schuhmann by mail at 1640 Lyndon Farm Ct. Suite 104, Louisville, KY 40223 or at the Striders' Ball prior to the drawing.
- Donations made on the website will be accompanied with a receipt emailed within 10 business days.
- The ticket is not needed to win, it is simply a keepsake
- 175 tickets will be printed and available.
- Purchasers should check with their tax preparer regarding tax components of their donations and/or winnings.
- The prize winner is responsible for any costs of the trip that are not specifically listed as a part of the prize package.
- An IRS form W-9 must be completed before prize award.
- Prizes are not transferable until after awarded.
- ACS staff and committee members and volunteers involved in the drawing operations may not buy tickets or win any prizes. This includes immediate family members of staff, the event chair, and the event co-chair.
- Immediate family of any ACS staff cannot win the prize. Immediate family members include spouses, partners, parents, or children. Extended family, not living in the household of a staff member may participate.

- Immediate family of Monteverdi Tuscany employees cannot win the prize. Immediate family members include spouses, partners, parents, or children. Extended family, not living in the household of a staff member may participate.
- Winning ticket will be drawn on November 18, 2017, at the Striders' Ball from physical ticket stubs placed in a drawing drum.
- If a winner declines a prize, they must sign a Drawing Prize Disclaimer form.
- A second ticket will be drawn the night of the Striders' Ball, should the winner declines the prize or is disqualified. The backup winner will not be announced.
- Must be 18 years or older to participate.
- The winner need not be present to win.
- Donations may be cash, credit card, debit card, and any form of check. Checks should be made out to the American Cancer Society.
- Donations associated with the drawing should be kept separate from other funds raised.
- Only Striders' Ball committee sign out the tickets to solicit donations.
- Tickets will be signed out in single form only.
- Event volunteer/participant must account for all tickets signed out and will be held accountable for missing tickets
- All ticket donation proceeds, ticket stubs, and undistributed tickets must be delivered to the ACS office or American Cancer Society fundraising event (2017 Striders Ball) or meeting by close of business on November 16, 2017.
